FILMING OF SAFETY VIDEOS

PortMate team started the filming of safe arrival and departure to small ports in Rauma in summer 2017.

The first small ports captured on film were ports of Syväraumanlahti, Poroholma, Kuuskajaskari and Kylmäpihlaja in Rauma, Finland. The filming was mostly carried out by using a drone to have a bird's eye view of the ports and the navigable routes. The drone clips were counterpointed by video from boat deck level.

The films are now being edited and will be published in spring 2018. Next summer, similar safety videos will be filmed in all PortMate ports, in both Åland and Sweden.
